### A MESSAGE FROM OUR STUDENT BOARD PRESIDENT

It's no secret that this past year has been challenging for everyone. It's been impossible to escape the anti-Israel flyers, social media posts, and protests. All the while, Israel still mourns the days of October 7th and faces shouts from the world to stop its endeavors to prevent the next one. Reflecting on the past year, being a Jewish college student hasn't been easy.

I remember opening my phone on October 7th and feeling lost. I also remember sitting in a cafe months later in Spain, seeing my fellow classmates having to deal with the fear of protests that hopefully wouldn't replicate the disasters that occurred at other Universities in the Northeast. However, I also remember sitting hand in hand with my fellow Jewish students the day I arrived back from the Texas/OU football game that frightful weekend in 2023. I remember driving with my friends downtown to meet up with the other students from Hillel and proudly marching downtown with my Israeli flag flowing from my back.

After October 7th, I understood more than ever before the importance of having safe Jewish spaces. When I was walking out of one of my classes, a student stopped me and asked about Hillel. 





### **Donor Spotlight**



#### **MORTON TOPFER, 2"I**

A true visionary and inspired leader. Mort Topfer developed an appreciation for Hillel's role in Jewish life when he was a student at Brooklyn College in New York. In later years, he became a successful entrepreneur and eventually a corporate executive at Dell Computers. During this time, in 1998, he learned from Austin-based Jewish leadership that Texas Hillel was embarking on a major renaissance and reimagining initiative, including rebuilding its outdated and undersized student home on the University of Texas campus. As an outgrowth of his own experience and inspiration for the importance of Hillel in providing "a home away from home" through services and programs for Jewish students, he and his wife made a leadership commitment to donate \$500,000 as an initial gift to the then developing Capital campaign, to be followed two years later by a supplemental \$1,000,000 challenge gift with the goal of eventually reaching the required six million dollar campaign total. Always a valued advisor, Mort's leadership in inspiring many additional individual and corporate donations, resulted in the successful completion of the fundraising goal in 2006 and the subsequent opening of the new facility, to be known as The TOPFER CENTER FOR JEWISH LIFE. Mort passed away in 2023 but his passion and determination leave a rich and meaningful legacy for Texas Hillel for all to know.

#### GLEN ROSENBAUM, z"I

A graduate of the University of Texas Law School, Glen was passionate about the positive impact of Hillel's role in the lives of Jewish students on the UT campus. His involvement with Hillel was enormous throughout the Renaissance years, beginning in 1998. During the following 25 years, he served in numerous volunteer leadership capacities, including as a valued legal advisor whenever such was needed, as a generous philanthropic donor to the annual operating budget, and with a personal donation to the then-new building capital fund campaign, which he designed and spearheaded. Most notably, he served for many years as Chairman of the successful campaign initiative, followed by his subsequent leadership as chair of the Endowment and Legacy Board. Throughout these years of involvement, he served with ceaseless commitment, pride, wisdom, and advice as a lay leader, always available during a challenging and much-needed rebirth on behalf of Texas Hillel and the Jewish community on the UT Austin campus. Thankfully, he witnessed the outcome of his commitment in 2006 with the opening of the Topfer Center for Jewish Life. Finally, he continued his involvement as an advisor and donor, including with a generous legacy gift. Sadly, he died too soon in 2023. He will be remembered for his leadership and philanthropy throughout the years.
